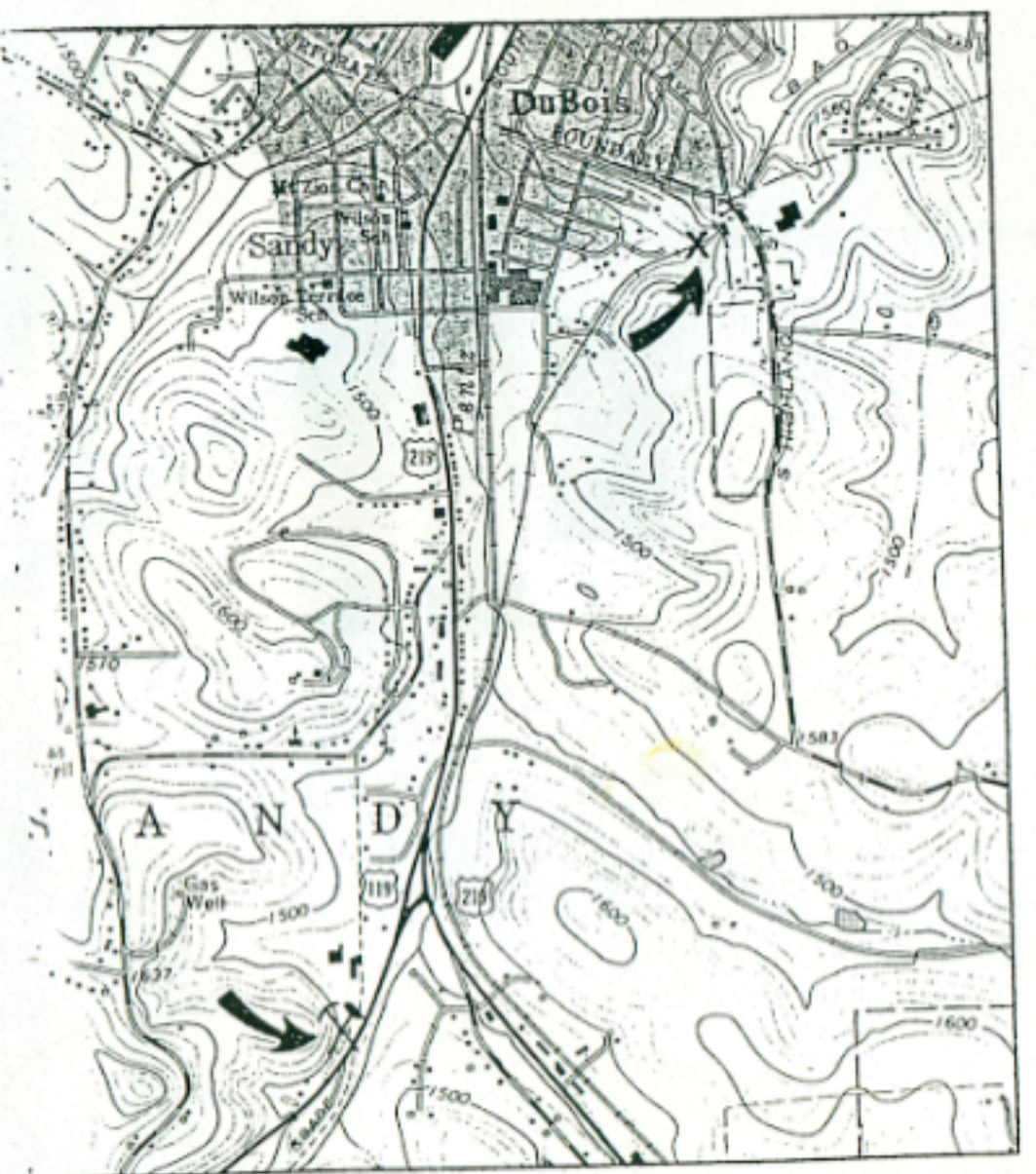


CLEARFIELD COUNTY

SITE 13—GASTROPODS AT DU BOIS

LOCATION. Several localities within a short distance of DuBois are replete with Pennsylvanian age gastropods. The locality of easiest access is borrow pit along U.S. Route 119, 1.5 miles south of the DuBois corporate line. It is 0.4 mile south of the intersection of U.S. Routes 119 and 219, on the west side of the road. The pit contains two levels from which the fossils were stripped. The fossil zone, which is the Brush Creek limestone,
